On Wednesday, June 26, 2014, the State College Police Department received a report of an indecent assault of a juvenile from another country while visiting the Boal Mansion located at 163 Boal Mansion Drive. The allegation was that Christopher G. Lee, age 65 of 163A Boal Mansion, indecently assaulted a juvenile male the first night he was staying at Lee's residence to do work at the Boal Mansion for part of the summer.

The State College Police Department immediately initiated an investigation and on June 30, 2014 executed four (4) search warrants on Lee's residence seizing potential evidence including personal computers and cell phone. The investigation yielded information that Lee has had teenage males from other countries visit his residence over the summer for numerous years.

The State College Police Department in conjunction with the Centre County District Attorney's Office requested the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) and the United States Attorney's assist in this investigation given the 17 year old victim and potentially other victims reside out of the United States. In addition, the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General, Bureau of Special Investigations, Computer Forensics Unit and the FBI were requested to conduct forensic analysis of all of the technology that the State College Police Department seized from Christopher Lee on June 30, 2014. Additionally, the Centre County Children and Youth Services and the Children's Advocacy Center of Centre County assisted in the investigation.

Based on the review of the information uncovered including the result of various forensic analyses, the United States Attorney's Office obtained a four count indictment against Christopher G. Lee on October 1, 2014. Lee was arrested this morning by the FBI and the State College Police Department.
