

## Population


The Plan includes information about the Borough's total population, age of residents, households, educational attainment, employment, and University enrollment and compares some of these traits to peer university communities.

The Plan also breaks down the population and age of residents for each Borough neighborhood.

## Housing

Information included in the Plan addresses the number, type and tenure of the Borough's housing units. A brief history of the Borough's development is outlined as well as a comparison of changes in the housing stock of the last 20 years. It also discusses housing affordability issues and other quality of life factors. The number of units, the percent of owner- and renter-occupied and the number of registered Student Homes are listed for each neighborhood.

A map is provided which shows the location of various types of rental units throughout the Borough. This information is based on 2013 information from the Centre Region Code Agency.





## Livability

In addition to data about who lives in the Borough and where they live, the Plan provides information about the characteristics of the community that make it a great place to live. This includes information on schools, parks and recreation, and transportation among others.

The Plan cites citizen's responses from the National Citizen's survey about residents feelings on the community. For instance,

In the 2012 National Citizen's survey,  
**82% of residents rated their neighborhood as an excellent place to live.**



Among other things, the Plan is an inventory of what is happening in the Borough today. It includes information at the Borough level as well as details on what is happening in each of the neighborhoods.
